- **Principal Mrs. Pritiben Patel** and **Ms. Bhoomiba Rana** also extended greetings.



National Sports Day Celebration



Debate Competition


To bring out the intellectual abilities of students, a **debate competition** was organized.

Smart Board Presentation


First-year commerce students gave presentations using smart boards on the subject “**Business Communication.**”

Amritsar:


- Visited **Golden Temple (Harmandir Sahib)** and **Jallianwala Bagh** — emotionally stirring and educational.
